However, the Foundation has persevered and stayed focused on serving its core mission.

As you will see, our financial position is strong, and our commitment to the mission of the Foundation is unwavering. The student and donor highlights presented on previous pages echo the values identified by the Board: education, opportunity, community, and stewardship.

During the year (July, 2008 – June, 2009), more than 600 of you contributed funds and in-kind donations to the Foundation. Thank you for your gifts, which have made lifealtering educational opportunities available to students.
