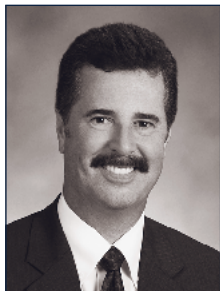

Displaced Homemakers Program Alum Gives Back

Sharon Cole found herself in need of training and a career path in 1978 when she enrolled in Skagit Valley College's Displaced Homemakers Program. The one quarter class provided encouragement for participants to believe in themselves and set educational and career goals.

Fast forward to 1999 when Sharon was asked to join Skagit Valley College Foundation as a board member after serving as a dedicated auction volunteer in the mid-1990s. During her tenure as a board member, Sharon witnessed the amazing impact scholarships have on the lives of students financially and emotionally. "I decided I wanted to find a way to help women who need financial assistance and a big emotional boost to go back to or stay in school. Scholarships provide that vote of confidence for students," Sharon explained.

She started providing scholarship support in 2001 and she continues to add to her endowed fund through gifts in memory of family and friends. Families who have received notice of her memorial gifts are deeply touched. "They often tell me how wonderful it is that I am helping women get back into the workforce in memory of their loved one. I feel so fortunate to be able to give back," Sharon said. Sharon's scholarship is awarded each year to students in SVC Life Transitions Program (formerly Displaced Homemakers).

"Our program enables students to move from confusion to confidence!" Margo Grothe, program coordinator, stated. "We help participants understand themselves and feel worthy to invest in their own futures—the motivation to map out an education, training or advanced employment plan. Critical scholarship support from generous donors like Sharon gives our students a vote of confidence and encouragement to keep moving forward in their training and career path." The program started 36 years ago and now serves more than 80 students each year at Mount Vernon and Whidbey Island campuses.
