Funds are available for students in one of the following areas: Applied Research, Professional Development, Scholarly Work, Interdisciplinary Work, Internships, or Program/Lab/Equipment Enhancements (instructors/Deans only). *Please Note: These funds are specifically intended to support and enhance student learning. Instructors may not apply for funds supporting their own research, professional development, scholarly work, etc.; however, Teacher-Scholar projects directly engaging students can qualify for funding. Also Note: These funds are NOT intended for tuition, fees, or books.*
